

### **Objective:**

- Provide assistance in support of rotational grazing plans and beneficial management practices;
- Support NEW fencing infrastructure and grazing plans;
- Offer exclusion fencing for livestock from waterways that align with rotation grazing; and
- Encourage and assist producers to implement alternative practices on their land.

#### Project Funding/Cost – Responsibilities:

Landowner

- 1. Agree to provide an invoice for fencing material purchased up to one (1) year prior to dated application.
- Shall not sell, trade or exchange fencing material.
  Rotational grazing fencing can be installed permanently or temporarily.
- 4. The cost of the labor and any equipment rental or use is the responsibility of the landowner.
- 5. Provide proof of project completion (i.e., before/after pictures; fencing installation and fencing completion).
- 6. Allow access for inspection and evaluation by SLWD staff and Board at any reasonable time and to determine eligibility.
- 7. Will be reimbursed by the SLWD once application is approved and project is complete, outlined below.
- 8. Will prepare proper seedbed for seeding rotational grazing area down as soon as practicable.
- 9. Ensure proper and sufficient permanent forage establishment and complete any maintenance required.
- 10. Willing to sign a landowner's agreement upon approval of project.
- 11. Be willing to complete Environmental Farm Plan (EFP).

#### Watershed District (WD)

- 1. Will fund 50% of cost to purchase fencing materials up to a maximum of \$5,000.00 based on the following fence types:
- three strand barbed wire, three strand wire, or one strand electric and may be permanent or temporary. 2. Cover the cost for fencing that is aligned with a rotational grazing plan only.
- 3. Does not support perimeter fencing, costs related to removing or replacing existing fencing, Texas gates, and ongoing maintenance.
- 4. Rotational Grazing project is a rebate program and cost-share will be reimbursed to the landowner after approval.
- 5. Ensure all required permits and agreements are in place prior to project start.
- 6. District is not responsible for any alterations or damage caused by beaver activity.

#### The Landowner Shall:

#### · Allow consent of entry onto property for purposes of the project;

- Provide access for inspection, evaluation, or further construction of the project by the WD at any reasonable or future time;
- Not alter, change, remove or modify the project without written consent of the District;
- Ensure agricultural use and practices do not alter or affect the integrity of the project;
- Allow the District to place signage at the project site; signage removal must be approved by the District prior to removal;
- Indemnify and save harmless the District from any and all actions, claims, suits, damages, injuries, or other loss no matter howsoever arising as a result of the construction, operation or maintenance of the project, and;
- Grant the Watershed District the right to use any information related to this project for educational or promotional purposes.

#### The Watershed District Shall:

• Reserve the right to reasonable access to project areas for tours, educational purposes or to inspect the condition of the project site at any time following completion of the project.

I hereby declare that I have read the conditions of this agreement, and that I agree to abide by the terms listed above. I further agree to cooperate to the fullest extent with the Watershed District Board and staff in completing and maintaining the project as outlined.
