## Project Funding/Cost - Responsibilities:

Municipality

- 1. Agree to pay a total of 60% invoiced cost for works (equipment/materials) completed plus an administration fee.
- 2. Make an upfront payment of half of the 60% cost share listed above plus an administration fee before the project start.
- 3. May use equipment and/or materials in-kind, where appropriate and timely, with safety consideration and WD approval.
- 4. Allow access for inspection and evaluation by SLWD staff and the Board at any reasonable time.
- 5. Will prepare proper seedbed for seeding area down as soon as practicable.
- 6. Ensure proper and sufficient permanent forage establishment and complete any maintenance required.
- 7. Willing to sign a landowner's agreement upon approval of project.
- 8. Private landowner, where project is completed on, is willing to complete an Environmental Farm Plan (EFP) for the RM.

#### Watershed District (WD)

- 1. Will pay 40% of invoiced cost for works completed, including materials and equipment.
- 2. Ensure all required permits and agreements are in place prior to project start.
- 3. Complete all required survey and engineering works, if required.
- 4. Provide contractor, equipment, and materials for project for District portion.
- 5. Supervise contractor as required.
- Will compare equipment usage to the Manitoba Heavy Construction Association's Equipment Rental Rates Guidebook and contractor and WD estimates.
- 7. Reimburse payment to landowner if an overpayment situation arises from agreed project minus the administration fee.
- 8. Ensure proper and sufficient permanent seed establishment and complete any maintenance required for 1 year following project completion date.
- 9. The district is not responsible for any alterations or damage caused by beaver activity.

### The Landowner Shall:

- · Allow consent of entry onto property for purposes of the project;
- Provide access for inspection, evaluation, or further construction of the project by the WD at any reasonable or future time;
- Not alter, change, remove or modify the project without written consent of the District;
- Ensure agricultural use and practices do not alter or affect the integrity of the project;
- · Allow a minimum 10ft, undisturbed and natural buffer along either side of the project area;
- Allow the District to place signage at the project site; signage removal must be approved by the District prior to removal;
- Indemnify and save harmless the District from any and all actions, claims, suits, damages, injuries, or other loss no matter howsoever arising as a result of the construction, operation or maintenance of the project, and;
- Grant the Watershed District the right to use any information related to this project for educational or promotional purposes.

## The Watershed District Shall:

• Reserve the right to reasonable access to project areas for tours, educational purposes or to inspect the condition of the project site at any time following completion of the project.

I hereby declare that I have read the conditions of this agreement, and that I agree to abide by the terms listed
above. I further agree to cooperate to the fullest extent with the Watershed District Board and staff in completing
and maintaining the project as outlined.
