Organization Summary:

The Swan Lake Watershed District (SLWD) is a municipally-based, non-profit organization made up of local people in partnership with the provincial government, private industry, and non-government organizations. The SLWD is governed by a Board of Directors comprised of municipally-appointed members, with significant input by sub-district members representing grassroots level people. The SLWD's co-operative mandate is to promote the sustainable use and management of land, water, air and related resources within the Watershed District.

DUTIES:

- Ground maintenance and conservation trail maintenance.
- Assist with water and soil health projects.
- Assist with surveying and data collection for district projects.
- Assist with watershed district programming which include, but not limited to, water testing, computer work for projects, educational events and other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS/SKILLS:

- Must meet requirements of Green Team and Canada Summer Jobs eligibility (age 15-29).
- Hold a valid Class 5F Manitoba driver's license.
- Able to work under minimal supervision.
- Able to work outdoors in all weather conditions.
- The ability to operate different machinery would be considered an asset.
(ie. Mowers, side-by-side, haul a trailer)
- Experience in conservation programs and/or agricultural programs is preferred but not required.
- Field experience is preferred but not required.
- Demonstrate good communication (written and verbal), interpersonal and computer skills.
- Experience working with Microsoft Office (MS Excel, Word etc).
- Preference will be given to those interested in Natural Resources Management, Agriculture, Environmental Sciences or currently enrolled in a degree/diploma in a related discipline.
